

A) GENERAL DISCLOSURE ABOUT ALL THE DATA HELD BY FACEBOOK AND ITS AFFILIATED COMPANIES (INCLUDING FACEBOOK INC., CALIFORNIA, USA)

1. All data about **my user profile itself, including:**

- 1.1 name(s),
- 1.2 contact information,
- 1.3 birth date,
- 1.4 visited institutions like school or workplaces,
- 1.5 passwords,
- 1.6 networks,
- 1.7 philosophy data,
- 1.8 information regarding arts and entertainment,
- 1.9 activities and interests,
- 1.10 and basic information, no matter on what page of the facebook platform.

2. All data of **related objects to my user profile, including:**

- 2.1 postings,
- 2.2 pictures,
- 2.3 videos,
- 2.4 apps,
- 2.5 links,
- 2.6 content from third parties,
- 2.7 and any other object, that show or relate to me, no matter if tagged or not and no matter on what page of the facebook platform.

3. All data about **relationships of the user with other data subjects, including:**

- 3.1 friendships,
- 3.2 former friendships,
- 3.3 proposed friendships,
- 3.4 relationships via objects (for example if two users were in the same picture, visited the same event, or belong to the same network, or site) as long as this indicates a personal relationship,
- 3.5 data from the 'friend finder',
- 3.6 sent or drafted messages,
- 3.7 copies of chats,
- 3.8 conversations via postings.

4. All **historical data, including:**

- 4.1 Any of the above data that is not up to date anymore, but still saved or used by the facebook platform (like deleted or changed information)

5. **meta and interaction data, including:**

- 5.1 IP-adresses,
- 5.2 configuration of devices,
- 5.3 information from tracking,
- 5.4 click-flows,
- 5.5 visitor counting,
- 5.6 activity indicators,
- 5.7 login- and logoff data,
- 5.8 log files of any kind
- 5.9 any properties of data related to the user (like data listed see above),
- 5.10 any indicators that target at the intensity of a relationship between users,
- 5.11 any indicators that target at the interest of users in a data subject or object
- 5.12 any information obtained from facebook elements on third party pages,
- 5.13 and any other statistics or meta data of any kind.

6. Outcomes of analytical procedures of any kind, including:

- 6.1 fraud protection measures,
- 6.2 analysing user satisfaction,
- 6.3 identity theft protection,
- 6.4 targeting for advertisements,
- 6.5 measures for the protection of IP rights,
- 6.6 of any other analytical procedure that facebook runs.
